

FINANCIAL CONTRACT

Explorations HomeBase Residential

The above fees and charges (excluding Intervention Fees, Travel/Escort Fees, and Sports fees) are due at the time of enrollment.

Tuition:

Monthly tuition fee covers costs for room and board, counseling, group sessions, laundry, basic toiletry items (see clothing & personal effects list) and other program needs and events. Special trips/expeditions, 1:1 care or wilderness interventions are in addition to tuition costs. Downhill skiing, special transportation costs, and tutoring are not included in the monthly tuition. (See schedule of individual expenses.) Days spent away from HomeBase during home or holiday visits will not be deducted from monthly tuition.

Individual Expenses:

Personal expenses will be billed as incurred according to the attached rate schedule. All medical, dental, laboratory and hospitalization, and prescription charges will be billed by the service provider directly to the Financial Sponsor. Financial Sponsor will be required to provide a credit card to secure payment at service providers at the time of enrollment. This will include, but not be limited to, physician/s, psychiatrist, dentist, orthodontist, and pharmacy.

Intervention Fees:

A special intervention requiring one-on-one care away from the HomeBase residential facility is provided as needed for participants experiencing difficulty assimilating in the regular program. Participants who require this type of intervention generally need 1:1 attention away from distractions as a 'time-out' to re-evaluate their behaviors and decision-making processes. A participant who requires this type of intervention may be demonstrating negative attention-seeking behaviors to the point of disrupting others in the program, may be relying on self-destructive types of behavior, and/or may be endangering self or others. Other conditions may warrant a special intervention. Parent/Guardian(s) will be notified in advance of the need for an intervention. Intervention may include a wilderness component, a portion or for entire intervention.

Escort/Travel Fees:

It might be necessary for a student to travel to home or other destination as recommended by therapist or as indicated by family. Sometimes it is necessary for the student to travel accompanied by a member of Explorations residential or clinical staff. In the event

this is recommended, the Financial Sponsor will be billed an additional \$200 per day plus any incurred travel expenses (such as airline tickets, lodging, car rental, etc) for such necessary travel. The Financial Sponsor will be notified in advance of the anticipated travel.

Payment Schedule:

The billing period is from the 1st through the last day of every month and tuition is billed one month in advance. Individual expenses for the prior month will be billed on the same statement. Tuition is billed on the 10th of each month and is due on the 1st of the following month. Students enrolling after the first date of any month will be charged at a rate of \$1,435.00 per week, and /or \$205.00 per day.

All fees are subject to late charges and will be considered delinquent if not received according to the above schedule. Late charges will be incurred at the periodic rate of 1 1/2% monthly or 18% annually.

Explorations will provide 30 days written notice of any increase in monthly tuition.

Transportation Fees:

See attached Schedule of Individualized Expenses.

Clothing, Personal Effects & Wilderness Gear:

See attached list for required items.

Medical Expenses:

Medical expenses are covered by Parent/Guardian(s) or insurance. Proof of insurance must be provided prior to enrollment. If proof of insurance is not provided, a \$2,000.00 medical emergency deposit will be required before the student can be enrolled.

Insurance Coverage:

In the event that there is personal property loss due to hazards including but not limited to fire, water damage, and natural disasters. All personal belonging of student will be covered under parent/guardians personal home owners insurances.

Enrollment Termination:

Termination by program: Explorations reserves the right to terminate enrollment at any time due to illegal, uncontrollable, or excessively dangerous actions by the participant, unreported or previously unknown medical conditions, behavior problems and/or disorders, prior injuries or for any other reason whatsoever deemed as necessary by Explorations. Non-payment of tuition and/or fees when due shall constitute sufficient reason for termination by Explorations. In the event of such termination by Explorations, the Financial Sponsor(s) shall not be entitled to a refund of tuition paid for the month during which termination occurs, nor shall the Financial Sponsor(s) be entitled to a refund of deposit.

Withdrawal by sponsor: In the event Sponsor(s) withdraws the participant prior to the end of a HomeBase residential program, or special intervention, or fails to give 60 day notice, (received in writing by Explorations 60 days before withdrawal) Sponsor(s) shall not be entitled to a refund of tuition or deposit fees and will be held accountable for all fees incurred until 60 day written notice is received by Explorations. Deposit fees will be used against any outstanding fees or tuition.

Deposit Refund:

The deposit received upon enrollment shall be refunded if: a) Explorations recommends to Sponsor(s) that Participant has completed his/her program and notifies Sponsor(s) in writing no less than 30 days before program completion OR b) Sponsor(s) decides to withdraw Participant and gives Explorations the required 60 day written notice. In all cases, the deposit will first be applied to any unpaid fees or tuition costs before it is refunded.

Explorations shall refund any unused portion of the deposit within 30 days of Participant's departure once the above-stated conditions are met.

General Provisions:

This is a binding contract which shall be construed and interpreted under the laws of Montana. No modification of this agreement will be valid unless evidenced in writing and signed by a representative of Explorations and the Financial Sponsor.

In the event any of the payments required under this agreement are not paid when due, Explorations shall be entitled to recover any and all costs, including attorneys' fees, which may be incurred in collecting past due notes.

I have read and fully understand the above agreement. As the Financial Sponsor for _____, I agree to the terms set forth in this agreement and guarantee to timely pay Explorations all fees, tuitions, deposits and charges pursuant to this agreement.
